(Seafaring) 2011

Tahuna Beach Convention Centre, Friday June 3rd to Monday June 6th 2011.

Greetings fellow 41 Club and Apex 40 members. The following is the format for a fun filled weekend.

The whole weekend will be based at the Tahuna Beach Holiday Park and Convention Centre at Tahunanui Beach, Nelson.

All available self contained units at the Holiday Park have been booked for us, and details are on a separate accommodation sheet.

All holiday park bookings are to be made through Nelson 41 Club at the address shown on the accommodation sheet. If you choose a motel, booking will be your responsibility.

There will be live entertainment on both the Saturday and Sunday nights.

We are expecting a contingent from Apex 40 in Australia to be with us for the weekend, and to hold their annual RORT (A.G.M.) at the same time we hold ours, (but in a separate room.)

Registration for the weekend will be NZ\$220.00 per person.

Programme - Registration Costs & Inclusions:

Friday evening:	Meet and Greet - finger food, with wine and beer provided
Saturday:	A morning in Nelson and the afternoon out and about, (transport provided). Lunch and in the evening a formal three course dinner with a bottle of wine per couple on the table
Sunday:	41 Club A.G.M. in the morning. Lunch, free afternoon and in the evening, a "fancy dress" dinner with a bottle of wine provided per couple on the table, followed by items from those present.
Monday:	A farewell breakfast before you head home.

2011 41 Club Convention Accommodation notes

Please read these notes fully, and then contact either Peter Butchart (details at the bottom of this letter) - **or** the motel of your choice.

We have the following accommodation available at the Tahunanui Holiday Park for Convention weekend.

1. 3 units – one double bed in each, sleep 2 - \$110.00 per unit per night.
2. 3 units – Queen or double bed in one room, 2 single beds in another room.
- \$150 per night, for 2 people or for 4 people.
3. 12 units – double bed, studio unit, sleep 2 - \$90 per unit per night.

All units are self contained- (linen supplied).

When making a booking, please tell us who you would like to share a unit with, otherwise we may put another couple in the unit with you. If you do not wish to share, please indicate, **but you will have to pay the full price as set out above.**

Units will be allocated on a **first come/first served basis** – i.e. - when we receive your request and a \$50 deposit per booking.

The balance will be due along with your completed Registration Form, which we will require by April 1st, 2011. Registration forms will be sent out early in 2011.

After that, we will do our best to meet your requirements.

If we have any questions we will contact you and talk to you about them.

Nelson 41 Club members will be responsible for allocating units, and all enquiries should be made to them – **NOT** the Tahunanui Holiday Park office please.

There are additional Holiday Park units available, but they require using shared bathroom and toilet facilities. If the need arises, we will use these, and you will be contacted to see if you are happy with these units, and you will be advised of the cost.

While there are more units at the Holiday Park, we have had to make provision for at least 50 Apex 40 visitors from Australia – their units have been reserved.

In addition to the accommodation at the Holiday Park, we have “*pencilled in*” units at the following three motels, all of which back onto the Holiday Park.
